



Rochester Rowing Club Drug & Alcohol Policy

The RRC does all in its power to discourage the abuse of alcohol and drugs by its members.

Any club member caught with illegal drugs on rowing club property, on a rowing-related trip or in proximity of those with illegal drugs will immediately be permanently banned from the club. If the rower is less than 18 years of age, their parents will immediately be notified. If the rower is on a trip or at an event, they will be immediately expelled from the trip at their own expense.

Any member less than 21 years of age caught with alcohol, any member that is caught serving alcohol to a minor, any member that is clearly intoxicated or any member that is caught in proximity with one of the above members will immediately be permanently banned from the club. If the rower is less than 18 years of age, their parents will immediately be notified. If the rower is on a trip or at an event, they will be immediately expelled from the trip at their own expense.

If the violation occurs at a regatta or on a trip to a regatta, any crew of which the violator is a member will not race. No substitutions will be made.

There will be no second chances. All decisions will be made by the consensus of the coaching staff. Appeals may be made to the Rochester Rowing Club board of directors.
